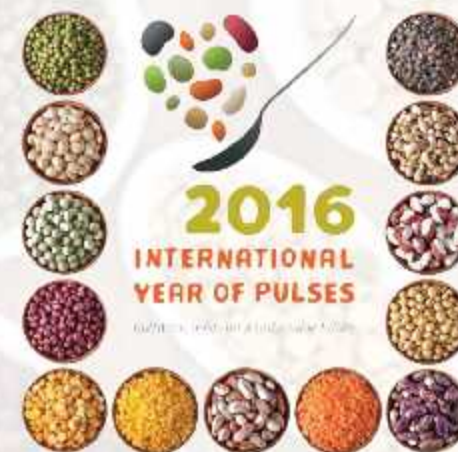

Theme of the Seminar

Pulses are the excellent sources of protein with low fat content. Pulses contain proteins, carbohydrates, dietary fiber, vitamins, minerals and phytochemicals (phenolic acid, anthocyanins) and their consumption and production increasing worldwide. Pulses comprise a number of bioactive substances including enzyme inhibitors, lectins, phytates, oligosaccharides and phenolic compounds that play metabolic role in humans or animals that frequently consume these foods. Pulses could prevent or manage chronic health issues such as diabetes, cardiovascular disease and obesity and contribute to overall health and wellness. Frequent legume consumption has been associated with 22% and 11% lower risk of coronary heart disease and cardiovascular disease, respectively. Hence, understanding the chemistry of pulses, nutritional benefits of pulses, phytochemicals for health through pulses, antioxidants in pulses are very important.
