Inscription on the Cover Page.

This inscription with the motif of *Nandi* was found at Gairidhara in Kathmandu, Nepal. It was issued by the king Arṅsuvarmman who styled himself as *mahāsāmanta*, from his headquarters at Kailāsakūṭa. It records that an irrigational channel was constructed at Niliśāla for which certain privileges were granted to the villagers.

Contains sixteen epigraphs relating to the great sage Vidya Aranya who wrote commentaries on the Vedas. He lived in the fourteenth century A.D., influenced contemporary life and was also instrumental in the founding of the Vijayanagara Empire.

All Prakrit inscriptions have been provided with Sanskrit versions. A Concordance of Prakrit and Sanskrit expressions is furnished as a separate Index. The Inscriptions relate to the dynasties of the Mauryas, Kushans, Kshatrapas, Satavahanas and Ikshvakus and others.
