

STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY – 2017

INTRODUCTION:

Students are the most important stake holders in the system of education. Quality and standard of educational system depends on the satisfaction of the students. It is needless to say that any educational institution ought to measure the students satisfaction level by conducting survey every year and necessary steps are to be initiated and problems are to be addressed effectively. Society is always susceptible to mutability and demands change in the educational system suiting to be needs and aspirations of the students varying time to time. Hence, educational institutes should measure satisfactory level of students time and again. This is an ever-ending, unperpetual and continuous process.

The IQAC of SCSVMV initiated a step to measure the student satisfaction survey in the year 2017 as per its road map. A questionnaire was developed and necessary changes are made in consultation with the experts suiting to the needs of the university and the same was adopted.

OBJECTIVES OF THE SURVEY:

- To find out the satisfactory level of the students with regard to four important parameters
- To find out the satisfactory level of male and female students with respect to the four important parameters.
- To find out the satisfactory level of the students of Tamil Nadu, AP/ Telangana and other states of the country

TITLE OF THE SURVEY:

“A study on the satisfactory level of the students of SCSVMV University-2017”

KEY WORD: **Satisfactory level**

Operational Definition: Here satisfactory level is measured as the percentage of sum total of responses of the students to the first three responses viz., Excellent, Very good and Good.

LIMITATIONS:

1. The study is limited to only our deemed university i.e. SCSVMV.
2. The study is limited to the students of the SCSVMV.
3. The study is limited to the four dimensions i.e. curriculum and teaching, infrastructure facilities, student support and progression and reputation of the university.

TOOLS USED:

A questionnaire titled “Student Satisfactory Survey – 2017” was developed and used by the IQAC.

PROCEDURE OF THE DEVELOPMENT OF THE TOOL:

- Four important dimensions viz. Curriculum & Teaching, Infrastructure Facilities, Student Support and Reputation of the University are finalized.
- A number of parameters under each heading were developed.
- A pilot study was conducted and some parameters were removed.
- Later the tool was sent to some experts and necessary changes were made and accordingly the parameters were finalized.
- There are 11 parameters in the development of curriculum and teaching; 6 parameters in the Infrastructure facilities; 12 parameters in the Student Support Services and 5 parameters under the dimension 'reputation of the university'.
- Along with some demographic variables, the questionnaire was put in the Google Forms.

SAMPLE TAKEN:

We have collected data from 2342 (63%) students of the total population 3715 of all the disciplines which includes the students of 17 departments.

METHODOLOGY FOLLOWED:

The following methodology is followed in collection of data from the students with respect to student satisfactory level:

- A reliable questionnaire was developed and put in the Google form to collect the responses from the students through on-line.
- A link was developed and put in the intranet of the university.
- All the Heads of the departments were explained regarding this filling of the questionnaire.
- Each Head of the Department made one of the members of faculty as in-charge to collect the responses from the students.
- Those members of faculty who were in-charge of collecting the responses from the students explained the procedure of filling the questionnaire to the students and collected the responses in the computer lab assigned to them. This procedure helps us to get the data from students genuinely.
- All the responses were collected in excel sheet and graphical representations of the data were made and also interpretations of the data were made.
- A detailed report was prepared and key recommendations were suggested.

Student satisfaction survey of students in the year 2017 collected with respect to 33 parameters of 4 dimensions with some open-ended questions. The responses with respect to Good, Very

good and Excellent together taken as satisfaction level of the students and fair and to be improved is taken as dissatisfaction of the students with respect to a particular parameter.

The above table clearly depicts that the student satisfactory level is good with respect to three parameters except student support services where the issues are to be addressed effectively.

There are 33 parameters for which the satisfactory level of the students is calculated. If satisfactory level is more than 60% it is taken it granted that the students are satisfied with that particular parameter. Out of 33 parameters students are satisfied with 26 parameters which means students are satisfied with 87% of the parameters.

Students are dissatisfied with the following four parameters where improvement is essential.

1. Canteen facility in the institution.
2. Fitness centre
3. Sports & Games
4. Hostel Maintenance.

The satisfactory level of the four parameters clearly indicates that the students are satisfied with all the four parameters.

Limitations:

1. The questionnaire was answered by both hostellers and Day scholars. Hence the satisfactory level exactly cannot be calculated.
2. People who never use/visited the fitness centre also responded to this parameter hence the value may not be quite accurate.

THE OVER ALL SATISFACTORY LEVEL OF THE STUDENTS IS 87% AND IS QUITE ENCOURAGING. WE WISH TO STRENGTHEN ALL THESE SERVICES TO ACHIEVE HIGHER SATISFACTORY LEVEL IN THE COMING YEARS.

MAJOR OBSERVATIONS

- 1) Overall satisfaction level of the students is 87%. It indicates that students are happy with various aspects of the university.
- 2) Students are happy with three dimensions viz. curriculum and teaching, infrastructure facilities and reputation of the university.
- 3) Students are very happy with respect to comprehensiveness of the curriculum, standard of syllabus, quality of teaching faculty, access to teaching faculty, quality of projects and assignments, fellow students' abilities, student-faculty relationship, NAAC "A" Grade of the University, and ready to refer our university for admissions.
- 4) Students are highly satisfied with the Library and its resources and highly dissatisfied with the Wi-Fi facility in the campus.
- 5) Students are not happy with the Wi-Fi facility, canteen, sports and games, fitness centre, hostels and Medical Centre activities.

KEY RECOMMENDATIONS

1. The strengths of the university are to be further strengthened.
2. Though Wi-Fi facility is available throughout the campus but students are most dissatisfied with this facility. It may be due to speed, non-functioning, very often and susceptible to hot, cold and raining climate. Care is to be taken to check and monitor the functions of the router and immediate actions are to be initiated. A separate person is to be entrusted for this purpose.
3. Students are not happy with the fitness centre. It may be due to inadequacy of the items available in the centre. Also modern and quality equipments may be procured and placed in the fitness centre.
4. Students are unhappy with the canteen facility. It may be due to high price of the items. It is expected that university canteen should sell the goods at subsidized prices.
5. Facilities in the hostels are to be enhanced.
6. More cultural events are to be organized in the campus. Two periods at a stretch may be allocated in the time-table of each department to exhibit the talents.
7. Every year students' satisfactory survey is to be conducted and accordingly steps are to be taken.

8. Apart from the student satisfactory survey, faculty satisfactory survey, parents satisfactory survey and alumni satisfactory survey are also may be conducted to arrive at a correct picture of the university administration.

ANALYSIS OF THE STUDENTS SATISFACTION SURVEY – 2017

I. CURRICULUM AND TEACHING

1. FACULTY QUALITY

1. The overall satisfaction of all the students of SCSVMV University with regard to quality of teaching and performance is 71%. It is an indication that the students are very much satisfied with the quality and performance of faculty of SCSVMV University.
2. 74% of the female students are very much satisfied with the quality and performance of teaching staff but 69% of these male students expressed their higher level of satisfaction. It is evident that female students' satisfaction percentage is more than male students. The reason may be due to less number of female students when compared to their counter parts.
3. 60% of Andhra-Telangana students, 81% of Tamil Nadu students, 66% students from other states expressed their satisfaction with regard to quality of teaching and performance of faculty.

4. Hostel Students expressed more satisfaction compared to day students. 69% of the Hostel Students are satisfied. Day scholars' satisfaction percentage is %.

2. SYLLABUS STANDARD

- The overall satisfaction of the students of the university with regard to the Curriculum Teaching and syllabus standard is 72%. This indicates that the students of the university are more satisfied with the syllabus standard as framed by the university.
- 75% of the female students are very much satisfied with the quality and standard of the university syllabus and at the same time 70% of the male students are much more satisfied with the qualify and standard of the university syllabus.
- While 67% of the Andhra and Telangana students satisfied with the university's standard and quality of curriculum syllabus, 78% of the Tamil Nadu students shown satisfaction about our university's standard and quality syllabus as compared to the Northern/Other states 65% students registered their satisfaction on our curriculum syllabus standard.
- 72% of the Hostel students very much expressed their satisfaction upon our university curriculum syllabus standard and quality as compared to 64% of the day students who shown the satisfaction on our standard of curriculum syllabus.

3. EVALUATION PROCEDURE

1. The overall satisfaction of the students of the university with regard to the evaluation procedures is 64%. This indicates that the students of the university are satisfied with the evaluation procedures in vogue in the the university.
2. 63% of the female students are satisfied with the quality and standard of the university evaluation procedures but and at the same time 61% of the male students are satisfied with the quality and standard of the university evaluation procedure. The satisfactory level of the female students is more than their counter parts. It may be due to small number of female students when compared to male students.
3. 61% of the Andhra and Telangana students, 63% of the Tamil Nadu students and 57% of other state students expressed their satisfaction with regards to university's standard and quality of curriculum evaluation procedures. It indicates students hailed from Tamilnadu are more satisfied and students from other states are less satisfied when compared to other two categories. This may be due to less number of students representing both Tamilnadu and other states.
4. 77% of the Hostel students expressed their satisfaction upon our university curriculum evaluation procedures when compared to 71% of the day scholars. It is clearly understood that hostel students are more satisfied with the evaluation procedures when compared to day scholars.

4. CURRICULUM COMPREHENSIVENESS

1. The overall satisfaction of the students of the university with regard to the comprehensiveness of the curriculum is 61%. This indicates that the students of the university are satisfied with the comprehensiveness of the curriculum in vogue in the university.
2. 64% of the female students are satisfied with the comprehensiveness of the curriculum but and at the same time 59% of the male students are satisfied with the comprehensiveness of the curriculum. The satisfactory level of the female students is

more than their counter parts. It may be due to small number of female students when compared to male students.

3. 54% of the Andhra and Telangana students, 72% of the Tamil Nadu students and 57% of other state students expressed their satisfaction with regards to comprehensiveness of the curriculum. It indicates students hailed from Tamilnadu are more satisfied and students from other states are less satisfied when compared to other two categories. This may be due to less number of students representing both Tamilnadu and other states.
4. 82% of the Hostel students expressed their satisfaction upon comprehensiveness of the curriculum when compared to 76% of the day scholars. It is clearly understood that hostel students are more satisfied with the comprehensiveness of the curriculum when compared to day scholars.

5. PROJECT ASSIGNMENT QUALITY

1. The overall satisfaction of the students of the university with regard to the projects and assignment quality is 70%. This indicates that the students of the university are satisfied with the project assignment quality standard as framed by the university.
2. 72% of the female students are satisfied with the projects and assignment quality but and at the same time 69% of the male students are satisfied with the projects and assignment quality. The satisfactory level of the female students is more than their counter parts. It may be due to small number of female students when compared to male students.
3. 62% of the Andhra and Telangana students, 78% of the Tamil Nadu students and 61% of other state students expressed their satisfaction with regards to projects and assignment quality. It indicates students hailed from Tamilnadu are more satisfied and students from other states are less satisfied when compared to other two categories. This may be due to less number of students representing both Tamilnadu and other states.
4. 69% of the Hostel students very much expressed their satisfaction upon projects and assignment quality when compared to 58% of the day scholars. It is clearly understood that hostel students are more satisfied with the comprehensiveness of the curriculum when compared to day scholars.

2. 71% of the female students are satisfied with the Access to teaching faculty but and at the same time 75% of the male students are satisfied with the Access to teaching faculty. The satisfactory level of the female students is more than their counter parts. It may be due to small number of female students when compared to male students.
3. 63% of the Andhra and Telangana students, 51% of the Tamil Nadu students and 61% of other state students expressed their satisfaction with regards to Access to teaching faculty. It indicates students hailed from Tamilnadu are more satisfied and students from other states are less satisfied when compared to other two categories. This may be due to less number of students representing both Tamilnadu and other states.

The satisfactory level of the female students is more than their counter parts. It may be due to small number of female students when compared to male students.

3. 65% of the Andhra and Telangana students, 62% of the Tamil Nadu students and 69% of other state students expressed their satisfaction with regards to Student-faculty Relationship. It indicates students hailed from Tamilnadu are more satisfied and students from other states are less satisfied when compared to other two categories. This may be due to less number of students representing both Tamilnadu and other states.

2. 65% of the female students are satisfied with the Quality of Laboratories but and at the same time 60% of the male students are satisfied with the Quality of Laboratories. The satisfactory level of the female students is more than their counter parts. It may be due to small number of female students when compared to male students.
3. 73% of the Andhra and Telangana students, 53% of the Tamil Nadu students and 53% of other state students expressed their satisfaction with regards to Quality of Laboratories. It indicates students hailed from Tamilnadu are more satisfied and students from other states are less satisfied when compared to other two categories. This may be due to less number of students representing both Tamilnadu and other states.

1. The overall satisfaction of the students of the university with regard to IT Infrastructure is 65%. This indicates that the students of the university are satisfied with the Adequacy of adornment of Classrooms.
2. 67% of the female students are satisfied with the IT Infrastructure but and at the same time 64% of the male students are satisfied with the Class rooms and Lab Infrastructure. The satisfactory level of the female students is more than their counter parts. It may be due to small number of female students when compared to male students.
3. 56% of the Andhra and Telangana students, 75% of the Tamil Nadu students and 51% of other state students expressed their satisfaction with regards to IT Infrastructure. It indicates students hailed from Tamilnadu are more satisfied and students from other states are less satisfied when compared to other two categories. This may be due to less number of students representing both Tamilnadu and other states.
4. 73% of the Hostel students very much expressed their satisfaction upon IT Infrastructure when compared to 58% of the day scholars. It is clearly understood that hostel students are more satisfied with the IT Infrastructure when compared to day scholars.
