**The fact that the University has entered its 25<sup>th</sup> year since inception and has planned to celebrate the “Silver Jubilee Year” spread over 2017-18, with a series of programmes in all departments was informed to the Hon’ble members. As a part of the same the commencement of the celebration and release of specially designed logo was held on 10<sup>th</sup> April 2017 in the presence of His Holiness Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Swamigal.**

Further during the discussions, Dr.T.P.Radhakrishnan, Hon'ble Member, proposed that the University has to organize Annual Talent Fests in Sanskrit programme similar to those conducted by the Rashtriya Sanskrit Vidyapeeth, Tirupati.

The suggestion was well taken and the Chairman informed that to conduct such kind of programmes large financial responsibilities would be necessary and we can approach some sponsors for the same. However we have planned all such kind of programmes to be conducted under the flagship event of Silver Jubilee Celebration.

### **32AC-7.2 To place the suggestion of the Patron.**

The Chairman informed that, His Holiness Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Swamigal, the patron of the university suggested to honour the Honorable President of India Sri.Pranab Mukherjee with appropriate citation with the flagship event of Silver Jubilee Celebrations. Accordingly it was decided to conduct a Special Convocation during July 2017. On the occasion His Excellency the President of India Sri.Pranab Mukherjee will be conferred with D.Litt. Honoris Causa. Certificates to research scholars and PG students who have been declared eligible to receive their degrees by duly appointed examiners during the academic year 2016-17, will also be awarded.

### **32 AC-8 ANY OTHER ITEM**

a. The Chairman informed about the introduction of a unit / module in the syllabus for all courses (Professional & Non-Professional) of the following three topics.

1. Cyber laws relating to start up projects and entrepreneurs.
2. Cyber security in general for all technical courses.
3. Essentials of GST in Commerce, Accounting and Management.

**The Council noted the same.**

b. With the permission of the Chair Dr.R.Vasanth Kumar Mehta, Head, Department of the Computer Science & Engineering informed that, the Computer Programming and Computer Programming Lab papers are being offered for all the B.E. (Full Time) Programmes in the First Semester as per the revision made in 2015. However, this has resulted in imbalance in the workload and lab utilization. Hence, it is proposed that the Computer Programming and Computer Programming Lab papers be offered only for B.E. (CSE) and B.Tech. (I.T) programmes in the First semester as per existing

systems, and for all other B.E. (Full Time) Programmes, these paper will be offered in the Second Semester instead of the First semester, by swapping with any existing subject along with lab. This will be practiced with effective from the Academic Year 2017-2018.

**The Council noted the same.**
