**1. Faculty of Sanskrit & Indian Culture**

The Chairman suggested that in the paper Sanskrit & Indian Culture the serial number fifteenth in the fifth unit to be replaced by including some portions from Deivathin Kural or from the discourse of Pujyasri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi Mahaswamigal. The included portion may be brought out as textbook for students.

**The council deliberated in detail on the recommendation and resolved that the Management may take a decision on the matter according to the necessity of the situation in a case by case consideration.**

#### **25AC-5.5 To start B.Sc. (Chemistry) Programme.**

**Resolved that the recommendations of the Board of Studies in Chemistry be adopted and shall be effective from the academic year 2014-15.**

#### **25AC-5.6 To start B.Sc. (Physics) Programme.**

**Resolved that the recommendations of the Board of Studies in Physics be adopted and shall be effective from the academic year 2014-15.**

**25AC-5.7 To consider vocational subject for admission to U.G. Programme in the University**

**Dr. N. Kumarappan suggested to introduce B.Sc. Programme in any of the Vocational subject by tapping resources from the Centre.**

**Resolved to consider a pass with required percentage (%) of marks in plus two examination in the vocational subjects (of any board / council / state) equivalent to a pass in any other examination eligible for admission to U.G. Programme, wherever possible.**

**25 AC-6.1 Student Intake**

**The Chairman informed about the student intake of different courses including newly introduced courses for the academic year 2014-15**

**It was suggested to introduce Training Programme in Electronics Design and Manufacturing for 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> passed candidates.**
