During the discussions, Dr.V.Kamakoti suggested that this University has a strong base in the field of Sanskrit and Indian Culture and the same may be productively exploited. We may develop courses of subjects related to ancient scientific thoughts of India and modern science with an interdisciplinary approach. It was also suggested that a committee may be appointed to prepare proposals for the same.

In this connection, it was decided to constitute a committee with the following members to prepare proposals on the thoughts of Indian Rishis and general sciences.

- 1. Dr.Abhiramasundaram, Professor, RM Vivekananda College, Chennai & Expert Member of the Academic Council**
- 2. Dr.S.Venugopalan, Associate Professor & HOD, Department of Sanskrit & Indian Culture & Member of the Academic Council**
- 3. Dr.S.Swaminathan, Professor & Dean, Faculty of Health Science & Member of the Academic Council.**

The action taken on the above items were reported.

The council noted the same.

The Vice-Chancellor announced that Dr.V.Kamakoti, Member, Academic Council, SCSVMV was awarded DRDO Academy Excellence Award 2013 for his outstanding contributions over several decades in the field of Scientific Research and Technology Development by Government of India and the same was presented by the Honorable Prime Minister of India.

The Chairman and members expressed their pleasure and congratulated Dr.V.Kamakoti for having been presented with such prestigious award.

Dr.V.Kamakoti accepted the recognition of the academic body, he announced the welcoming information on the acceptance of the IIT, Madras to consider Tie-up with our University. It was suggested that a function can be arranged in the University inviting reputed industrialist to Chair, for signing the MoU.
