Topic: Application of Sanskrit to improve Higher Education in India

Power-point Presentations must be made on their own. 7 minutes will be given to participants for the presentation. Presentation must be related to the theme otherwise it will lead to disqualification. Maximum two students can present jointly.

Vocal Solo

Any Sanskrit song can be sung. Other than Sanskrit song will not be entertained.

5 minutes will be allowed to sing the song. Instrument is also allowed. Karaoke is not allowed.



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Painting

Topic: Participants must paint the scene depicted in one of the following slokas.

(Abhijnana-Sakuntala Act 1 Sloka 7)

Meaning: Dushyanta describes the deer that is frightened by seeing him and the deer runs very fast to save his life. - 'The deer, while running, beautifully bends back its neck and casting its eyes often at the chariot. The deer shrinks the back portion of its body to the front half due to the fear of the fall of arrows. Its mouth was filled with the *dharbha* grass. The deer ate only half of it and the remaining grass slipped from its mouth due to fatigue and the path was scattered with dharbha grass. It runs very fast because of which it jumps high and seems to travel more in the sky and runs very less on the earth.'

Meaning: These rows of sarasa (crane) birds on the banks of River Godavari hearing the jingles of the tiny golden bells suspended in the interior of this aircraft are soaring to the sky as if coming forward to meet you welcomingly.

Time: 2 hours

Only drawing sheets will be provided. Other materials must be arranged by the participant.

One Act Play

Theme : Any theme related to Indian Culture.

Language : Sanskrit / Tamil / English

Only one team is allowed from a college or department (of SCSVMV). A team must consist of 10 participants only. 7 minutes will be allowed to each team for play. 5 minutes will be given stage arrangements. Play must not contain any anti-social scene.

Classical Dance

Any Indian Classical Dance can be showcased. Dances being showcased only on classical music will be entertained. No dance will be entertained on film songs. Participants must have to arrange dress and other make up items on their own.



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Short Film

- 1. The language of the short film can be Sanskrit, Tamil, English focused on Importance and Features of Sanskrit or Indian Culture.
- 2. Only one Short-Film from an institute is permitted. Duration of the Short-Film must not exceed 15 minutes.
- 3. The story of the short film must be of your own. It must not be taken from any other film or story. If so, then a letter of no objection from the original author must have been obtained and copy should be submitted to SCSVMV for reference.
- 4. The short film must not contain any scene screening violence of any human or any animal in the film. Also it must not contain any scene, harming the believes of any caste, creed or religion otherwise the film will be disqualified.
- 5. The short film must be submitted in digital format which can be opened and played using Windows Media Player without any additional installations and settings.
- 6. The short film can be submitted by 21 September, 2018 at the Dept. of Sanskrit & Indian Culture, SCSVMV. It must be submitted in a DVD. Please check the DVD before submitting. Short film name and submitting institution's name must be written on the DVD without fail. (It is ideal to bring the same film on another DVD and a pen drive as a backup).
- 7. The Short Film has to be submitted along with the Entry Form. Mentioning the names of all film crew members in the entry form is compulsory.
- 8. Decision of the jury / judges will be the last and final.
- 9. The short film will also be the property of SCSVMV and the original author.
- 10. A representative for the Film must be present at the time of screening at Samskritotsava.
