Principal had welcomed all members and initiated the discussion.

The discussion was about the guidelines to run the post graduation courses in Ayurveda in five departments M.D.(Ay) / M.S.(Ay). After thoroughly going through the Post Graduate MSR-2016 and Syllabus prescribed by CCIM, members took the following recommendation and forwarded to the academic council to pass for implementation from 2019-20 batch onwards.



1. FRAMING OF THE SYLLABUS:

The syllabus prescribed by the CCIM for M.D. (AY) & M.S (AY) to be strictly followed without any change / alteration.

2. NOMENCLATURE OF PG DEGREE:

The Post-Graduate Scholars shall be awarded their PG degree with following nomenclature.

3. EXAMINATION PATTERN:

- a. In first year MD/ MS Ayurveda course, at the end of the 1st year all candidates shall attend 02 theory examinations.
 - Theory Paper I Research methodology and medical statistics which is common for all candidates. (Theory 100 Marks, Practical & Viva voce 100 marks, Total = 200 marks)
 - Theory paper II, Subject oriented / Subject specialization (Theory 100 Marks, Practical & Viva voce 100 marks, Total = 200 marks)

All first examinations shall be completed before the end of 12 months including practical and viva voce.

b. At the end of final year MD/ MS Ayurveda candidates shall appear subject oriented examination with 04 theory papers, one practical and viva voce. Each theory 100 marks and 01 practical 100 marks (Theory 4 papers X 100 marks = 400 Marks and Practical & viva voce 100 marks = Total 500 marks)

All final / Third year examinations shall be completed before the end of 36 months including practical and viva voce.

4. QUESTION PATTERN

For all MD/ MS Ayurveda examinations the question pattern will be subjective.

All questions are compulsory and to be answered in English only and Sanskrit wherever necessary.

All questions shall carry equal marks.

Number of essay questions - 10, each questions carries 10 marks,

Total 10 questions X 10 marks = 100 marks

5. CONDUCT OF EXAMINATION (Month / Year of Examinations):

The First year MD, MS Ayurveda examinations shall be conducted in twelve month from the commencement of the course.

The Final Year MD, MS Ayurveda examinations shall be conducted in thirty six month from the commencement of the course.

6. ATTENDANCE

PG Scholars shall require minimum of 75% Attendance to appear for the examinations. Between 70% and 74% may be recommended for condonation.

7. HOW MANY EXAMINATIONS TO BE CONDUCTED IN THREE YEARS:

All MD, MS Ayurveda candidates have to appear two examinations irrespective of their specialization.

- i. At the end of the first year (before the completion of 12 months)
- ii. At the end of final year (before the completion of 36 months)
 - Supplementary examination shall be conducted every 6 months to the failed candidates.
 - The candidates shall clear all first year examination before appearing the final year examination.
 - In case if the candidate has not cleared the first year arrear examinations before final
 year examinations, he/she is not eligible to appear the final year examinations and
 he/she will lose PG degree.

If any candidate discontinues his/her course during 36 months, he/she may be allowed a break period of one year only. If this period extends more than one year he/ she lose the PG degree.

8. FRAMING OF MARK SHEET

Post graduate mark sheet template first year and final year attached here with.

9. FINAL DATE FOR SUBMISSION OF SYNOPSIS / DISSERTATION

All MD, MS Ayurveda scholars have to submit their synopsis within 06 months from the date of commencement of course. Candidates have to submit their final thesis/ dissertation 06 months before the commencement of their final year examinations.

10. TO DISCUSS ABOUT THE REMUNERATION OF THE EXAMINER

As per the norms of University / if necessary other University may be consulted

11. NUMBER OF EXAMINERS TO CONDUCT EXAMINATION

· For first year examination in post graduate course

One internal and one external examiner (1+1=2) for research methodology and one internal and one external examiner (1+1=2) for medical statistics are required to conduct the practical and viva voce examination.

For concern subject One internal and one external examiner (1+1=2)

Duration of examination - one day

· For final year examination in post graduate course

Two internal and two external examiners (2+2=4) are required to conduct the practical and viva voce examination and duration of examination will be one day only.

12. OTHERS

- a. There must be different committees viz
 - Post graduation committee: The committee people shall thoroughly go through the synopsis and finalize the title of the synopsis and make it sure that no other PG scholar has done same research work.
 - Scientific committee: To see the methodology, study protocol, groups, work done
 earlier, A PG student selecting a new drug from traditional medicine, the committee

should see that whether it has been published, authenticity of the traditional practitioner and their undertaking.

- Institutional Ethical committee: will examine the safety of the patient with regard to
 heavy metal toxicity, drug toxicity, informed consent form from patient, and any other
 ethical issues related to patients. The synopsis to be presented before the IEC for
 approval before starting clinical study. After getting ICE approval will be sent to
 Research & Publication Department for registration.
- Research & Publication Department has to provide the registration number to the candidate to start the research work.

B. Post graduate scholars have to submit their MD/MS Ayurveda Thesis / Dissertation within 200 pages.

They have to provide one copy each to central library, dept. library, guide/ co guide apart from the university copy.

Scholars are allowed 15 days of CL per calendar year
