Semester VIII

Entire semester will be devoted to Industry Internship. The Internship will carry 8 credits and the Internship report should be evaluated and the viva-voce examination shall be conducted by an experienced faculty from a reputed University. The marks shall be awarded in the following proportion:

Internship Report: 75 Marks

Viva: 25 Marks

Total: 100 Marks

Duration of the Course:

- Visualized and framed for 4 years and 8 semesters as per the latest National Educational Policy (NEP) released by MHRD.
- Each academic year shall be divided in 2 semesters. Odd semester shall consist of period from June to December of each year and even semester from January to May of each year. Each semester comprises of 90 working days.

ELIGIBILITY

- Candidates for admission to the first year degree of the B.Com (Hons) programme shall be required to have passed plus two Examination with an aggregate of 75% marks in Commerce group consisting of papers such as Commerce, Accountancy and Business Mathematics/ Computer Science.

COURSE OF STUDY

The main subject of study for the B.Com (Hons) programme shall comprise of the following:

- PART-1: Languages (Tamil/Sanskrit/Hindi)
- PART-2: English
- PART-3: Core Subject, Project, Internship.
- PART-4: Non-Majors.
- PART-5: Extension Activities. (NSS)

CURRICULUM

Curriculum designed as per the following points

- 27 Core courses were finalized for 7 semesters and they are made compulsory with 4 credits each.
- 4 Allied courses were designed for first 2 years covering 4 semesters with 4 credits each. (1 computerized accounting system)
- 5 Elective courses were designed from 3 year comprising of 3 semesters with 4 credits.
- 7 Soft Skill courses (1 soft skill course in each semester) as additional optional subjects (NPTEL) with 2 credits each if a candidate is passed in NPTEL course 2 credits can be given.
- 4 Non major courses were included as additional optional subject with 2 credit each.
- Summer project will be carried out in 7th semester with six credits.
- Entire 8th semester is designed for internship and major project with 8 credits.

- Every semester will be concluded with a comprehensive viva in all subjects put together with 14 credits (2 credits each semester)

INDUSTRY COLLABORATION

The programme is suggested to run with collaboration from industry. An MOU can be entered with organizations of repute (minimum 4 companies) where in the following points should be made mandatory:

1. 25% of the selected papers (mutually agreed between university and industry) to be taught by the practicing managers from industry.
2. Internship should be provided to students by the same industry
3. Eligible students to be provided placement opportunity
4. Companies can be selected from the following sectors:
 - Banking
 - Insurance
 - IT
 - Chartered Accountancy (turnover should be more than a crore)
 - Manufacturing

TRANSFER FROM B.COM(GENERAL) TO B.COM(HONS)

- A Transfer from B.Com (General) to B.Com(Hons) will not be possible as the subjects taught are entirely different from the beginning.

FOREIGN PROSPECTS

A four year B.Com (Hons) programme will be accepted automatically by foreign universities and they will be eligible to get H1 visa especially for USA.
