STUDENT SOLAR AMBASSADOR programme is an initiative of IIT Bombay. A one-day workshop for students of age group from 11 to 30 years was organised through Unnat Bharat Abhiyan scheme at SCSVMV Deemed University, Kanchipuram on 02nd Oct, 2019. This event is also organised as part of 150th birth anniversary celebrations of Mahatma Gandhi. Around 200 students participated in the workshop. Students were given training to assemble their own solar study lamps.

The workshop began with prayer followed by Mahatma Gandhi's favourite bhajan Vaishnavo Janato by the University music team. Prof.Dr.K.venkatramanan, Co-ordinator, UBA welcomed the gathering and explained the objectives of organising the event. Prof.G.Srinivasu, Registrar delivered Presidential address. Oct 2nd is observed as **International day of Non-violence**. Dr.V.Ragavendran, Asst. Prof. of Physics read the **pledge on non-violence towards environment** and the dignitaries and participants took the pledge. Sri. 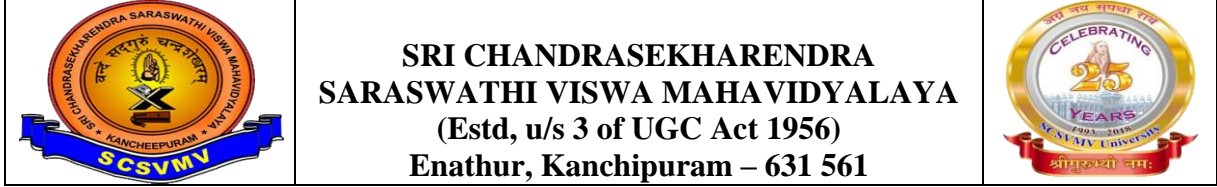

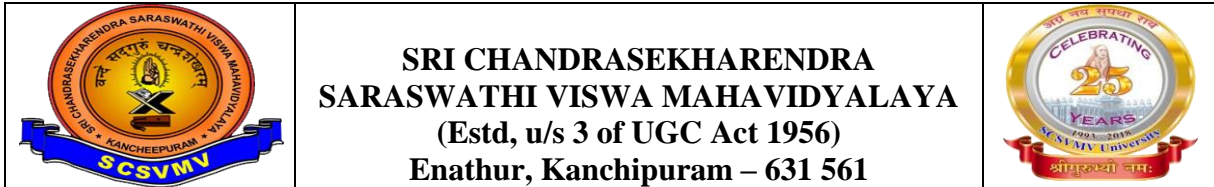

IN WIRELESS SENSOR NETWORKS**

Synopsis :

The most considered issues include security and energy, since nodes are built with limited energy. Administering agent with middleware functionalities help to improve network performance. A mobile agent is a node or program that can move through the network from node to node autonomously performing various tasks. Mobile agents are often implemented as middleware. Middleware is used widely in computing systems to bridge the gap between the operating system and high-level components and to facilitate the development and deployment of applications. In order to extend the functionalities of mobile agents to support security along with network performance improvement data gathering based on trust is imposed over the agents and the same is analyzed for the performance improvement. In Collaborative intelligent mobile agents technique the functions are distributed to reduce the overloading and complexity in processing. The mobile agents with different functions are collaborated to improve the security and performance improvement.

Research Topic

**RF ENERGY HARVESTING SYSTEM FROM MOBILE CELL
TOWERS FOR LOW POWER DEVICE**

Synopsis :

Topic of Research Colloquium is RF energy harvesting system from mobile cell towers for low power device. In this presentation, about an experimental RF energy harvesting system to harvest energy from mobile cell towers. A system will be presented using existing antenna and charge pump technology to charge a cellular phone battery without wires. In this first step, we will use a standard phone, and incorporate the charging technology into a commercially available base station. The base station will contain an antenna tuned to 915MHz and a charge pump. The system design consists of three modules: a single wideband 377Ω E-shaped patch antenna, a pi matching network and a 9-stage voltage doublers circuit. These three modules were fabricated on a single printed circuit board. A Schottky diode-based single stage voltage doublers and nine-stage voltage doublers has also been designed and fabricated for DC voltage generation. Excepting results show that a voltage of 3.2V is obtained at a distance of 10m from the cell tower and a voltage of 0.92V is obtained at a distance of 50m. It seems these days that everyone has a cellular phone.

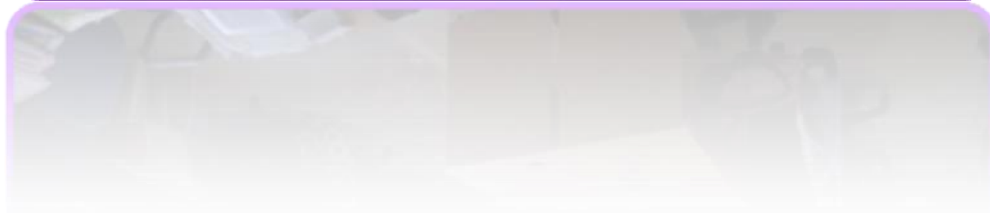
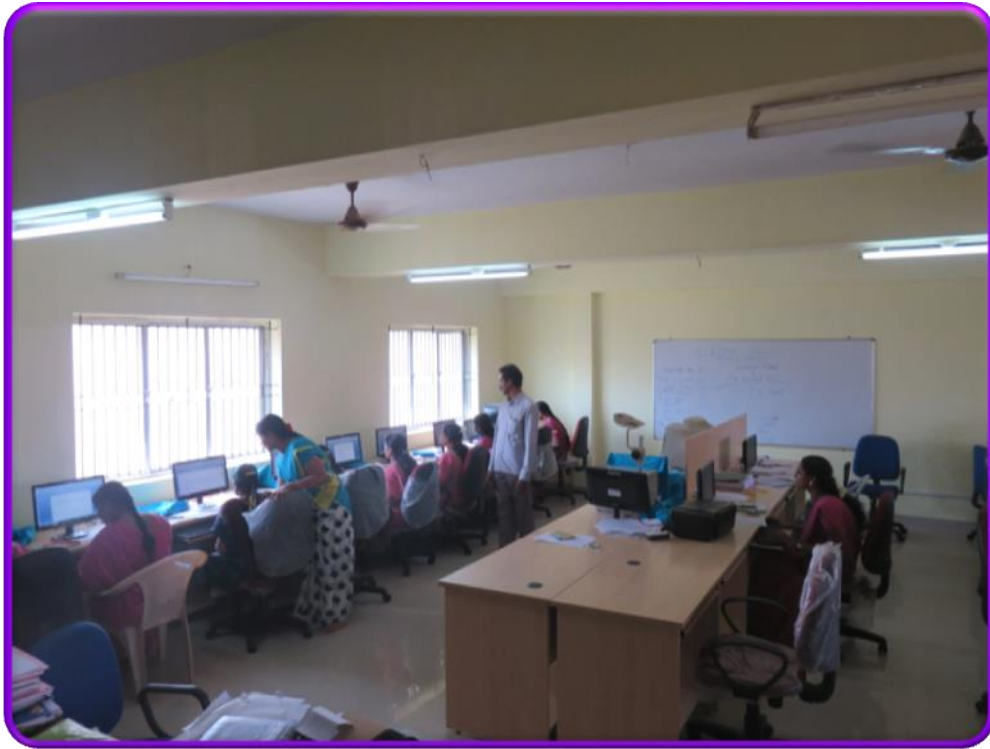
WORKSHOP ON ‘SOCIALLY USEFUL PRODUCTIVE WORK-I’ (19.10.2016)


