You are requested to step up anti-ragging mechanism by way of adequate publicity through various mediums; constitution of anti-ragging committee and anti ragging squad, setting up of Anti Ragging Cell, installing CCTV cameras at vital points, Anti- Ragging workshops, updating all websites with nodal officers complete details, alarm bells etc. Regular interaction and counseling with the students, identification of trouble-triggers, mention of Anti-ragging warning in the institution's prospectus and information booklets/brochures shall be ensured. Surprise inspection of hostels, students accommodation, canteens, rest cum recreational rooms, toilets, bus-stands and any other measure which would augur well in preventing/quelling ragging and any uncalled for behavior/incident shall be undertaken.



2. In continuation of the Government letter 2nd cited, I am directed to enclose a copy of the minutes of Meeting of the State Level Monitoring Cell held on 08.12.2018 and request you to take meticulous follow-up action on the decision of the minutes as follows and report the same to the Government.

- (i) All Educational Institutions of higher education should have Anti-ragging Committees. The committee meetings should take place once in the month of June and again on the day the College reopens.

Action: The Director of Collegiate Education, the Director of Technical Education, the Director of Medical Education, the Director of Legal Studies, the Registrars of all Universities, and the Vice-Chancellors of all Universities, the Secretaries of Departments concerned and District Collectors are reminded to ensure formation of Anti-Ragging Committee in all Educational Institutions and that committee meetings should take place once in the month of June and again on the day the College reopens.

- (ii) These committees should be constituted in a comprehensive manner for which the model practiced in other States like Maharashtra may be examined.

Action: The model composition of the Anti-Ragging Committee followed in Maharashtra is enclosed herewith for necessary action.

- (iii) The meetings of the District Level Anti-Ragging Committee should be held under the Chairmanship of the District Collectors in the month of June and again in the month of July.

Action: The District Collectors are reminded to conduct District Level Anti-Ragging Committee meeting in the month of June and again in the month of July.

- (iv) All Universities including deemed Universities should have Anti-Ragging Monitoring Cells headed by the vice Chancellor for which the Registrar will be the convener. They should include a representative from the police department.

Action: The Vice-Chancellors of Deemed Universities and the Secretaries of Departments concerned are requested to adhere strict compliance of said decision as the monitoring cell has observed that compliance from Deemed Universities is not up to the mark and vigorous follow-up is required.

- (v) All cases of ragging should be instantaneously acted upon by the Anti-Ragging Committee and the report to the state monitoring cell furnished by the University monitoring cell within 24 hours. The Principal of the concerned educational institution and the Registrar of the concerned University may be asked to be present at the meeting of the state monitoring cell, if considered necessary.

3...

Action: The Vice-Chancellors of Deemed Universities, Secretaries of Departments concerned and the Director General of Police is informed that police action shall be initiated on Deemed Universities, after discussion at the State Level Committee, if they fail to take action on ragging incidents in violation of UGC Regulations 2009.

- VII. With regard to deemed Universities it is noticed that the anti-ragging cells have not been formed in many Universities. The concerned Secretaries to Government should get in touch with the Universities and ensure immediate compliance. The reports of the Vice Chancellors should be submitted to the State Monitoring Cell through the concerned Secretaries to Government in case of deemed Universities.

Action: a) The Secretary, Health and Family Welfare is requested to instruct Deemed Medical Colleges / Universities and to obtain a report on the constitution of Anti-Ragging Committees and any occurrence of Anti-Ragging incident in these Deemed Colleges / Universities and report the same to this department.

b) The Secretaries concerned are informed that they should attend the next Anti-Ragging Committee meeting under the chairmanship of the Hon'ble Governor if total compliance of formation of Anti-Ragging cells is not reported.

- VIII. Strict Action should be taken against those indulging in ragging. The norms on the nature of action to be taken will be discussed in the next meeting.

Action: The vice-Chancellors of all Universities / Deemed Universities are instructed to pass resolutions in the Syndicate meeting to the effect that non-constitution of Anti-Ragging Committees in the affiliated colleges will attract a fine up to Rs.1 Lakh / Rs.5000/- per day till such committee is formed. Such punishment or negligence shall be imposed after giving 15 days' notice.

- IX. To strengthen the rules framed under Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act. (Tamil Nadu Act 7 of 1997)

Action: The Director of Collegiate Education / Director of Technical Education is requested to ensure that the proposed amendments / guidelines to strengthen the rules framed under Tamil Nadu Prohibition of Ragging Act. (Tamil Nadu Act 7 of 1997) is in accordance with UGC Regulations 2009.

XXXX

6.4.1. The Anti-Ragging Committee:- Every institution shall have an anti-Ragging Committee and an Anti-Ragging Squad. The Anti-Ragging Committee shall be headed by the Head of the institution and shall consist of representatives of civil and police administration, local media, Non Government Organizations involved in youth activities, faculty members, parents, students belonging to the freshers' category as well as seniors and non-teaching staff. It shall monitor the Anti Ragging activities in the institution, consider the recommendations of the Anti-Ragging Squad and take appropriate decisions, including spelling out suitable punishments to those found guilty.

The Director of Collegiate Education, the Director of Technical Education, the Director of Medical Education, the Director of Legal Studies, the Registrars of all Universities, and the Vice-Chancellors of Deemed Universities and the Secretaries of Departments concerned have been requested to broaden the anti-ragging committee constituted in the Institutions under their purview like that of Maharashtra. The District Collectors have been advised to ensure this.

Decision:

The decision has been communicated to The Director of Collegiate Education, the Director of Technical Education, the Director of Medical Education, the Director of Legal Studies, the Registrars of all Universities, and the Vice-Chancellors of Deemed Universities and the Secretaries of

Departments ~~for~~ necessary action. Further the Director General of Police has been requested to take instantaneous strict action against those indulging in ragging and as and when ragging cases are registered.

Police action shall be initiated on Deemed Universities, after discussion at the State Level Committee, if they fail to take action on ragging incidents in violation of UGC Regulations 2009.

Either the Regional Joint Director of the District or a Senior Principal of a College designated by the Regional Joint Director in charge of that District, shall be the Nodal officer for the District Anti-Ragging Committee and shall coordinate with the Collector for timely conduct of the meetings.

The Director of Collegiate Education and the Director of Technical Education was requested to designate a Nodal Officer for the District Anti-Ragging Committee either in the level of Regional Joint Director of the District or a senior Principal of a College designated by the Regional Joint Director incharge of that District to coordinate with the Collector for timely conduct of the meetings.

Decision:

The monitoring cell noted this.

AGENDA- VII

With regard to deemed Universities it is noticed that the anti-ragging cells have not been formed in many Universities. It should be ensured that a total compliance report after due check by Higher Education Department shall be submitted to the Hon'ble Governor before 31st March, failing which a meeting of the State Monitoring Cell will be convened in April 2019 to peruse the list of defaulters.
