




Session 1: Prof. V. Swaminathan





Session 1: Dr. M. SenthilKumaran



Session 1: Dr. LakshmiBai








DAY 6: 21-10-2021



Session 1: Dr. R. Jayalakshmi






Session 2: Dr. S. S. Devika

Session 1: Dr. K. Venkatraman




Session 2: Dr.P.Vekatesan

Session 1: Dr. K. Sivakumar





Session 1: Dr. T. Pushpanathan





Session 1: Dr. S. Vijayaraghavan



Session 2: Online Feedback Submission


