SCSVMV ADMISSION POLICY 2021-22

***Mission:** Achieve 100% admissions of qualified and competent candidates to various academic programmes of SCSVMV*

We are happy to announce **Scholarship Schemes** spanning several dimensions such as *scholastic achievement, neighbourhood affinity, alumni connect, promotion of Indian tradition and culture, and employee happiness*. Based on the trends of past years, and taking into account the Covid situation faced by the Nation, we have designed the Admissions Policy in order to enhance the agility and dynamism in the admissions process.

A. Background:

Seat Intake Capacity: The intake for all the programmes are **the same as last year**; however, we have surrendered 245 seats in the Post-Graduate Engineering Part time programmes to AICTE due to “no demand for admissions” for these courses for the last six years.

Cut Off marks: The **cut-off percentages/marks** are as per the norms formulated by regulatory bodies such as AICTE, UGC, NCTE, and Ayush/CCIM; however, in some select disciplines, a higher cut-off is set based on market trend and to ensure quality of students admitted.

The details of the seat intake capacity for Admission 2021-22, cut-off marks, and the corresponding course fee are given in *Annexure-I*.

B. Scholarship Schemes:

In order to *recognize, reward, and encourage meritorious students* at the time of admission and to ensure that no deserving student misses a chance to pursue his/her education due to financial inability, especially during the current **pandemic** situation, **a series of Scholarship Schemes** are introduced, rationalizing the existing schemes and introducing new ones. *Annexure II* contains the details of these schemes.

S.1 Promotion of Indian tradition and culture: Sanskrit and Indian Culture is the soul and bed-rock of our Deemed University. In alignment with the organizational goals and in keeping with the tradition in the past years, a *full fee-waiver* is available for eligible candidates.

S.2 Scholastic achievement: In order to encourage meritorious students to pursue the study of Pure Sciences, Mathematics and other related programmes, Scholarships are offered as fee concessions based on the marks obtained in the qualifying examination.

S.3 Shaping the Teachers of tomorrow: Teachers are the backbone of our nation. A special scholarship scheme encourages students to pursue B.Ed. programme.

S.4 Making the creative design engineers of tomorrow: In order to produce creative designers of engineering artifacts, scholarships to attract meritorious students to pursue Engineering programmes are introduced in a new format.

S.5 Alumni Connect: Besides encouraging Post graduate studies through one-time support, we encourage our alumni to pursue their Higher education with us.

S.6 Neighbourhood Affinity: As a social-welfare measure to encourage the children from the neighbourhood to higher education, we enhance the on-going one-time concession for the *First Graduate* from a family.

S.7 Enhancing Employee Happiness Quotient: Our University's commitment to the welfare of its employees is well-known. The on-going Employee Welfare scheme is the scholarship that provides *fee concession* to an employees' ward to pursue the programme of choice, subject to eligibility.
