(54) Title of the invention : AYURVEDIC MEDICINE PREPARATION-SMART FLOUR MAKING MACHINE

(57) Abstract :

Ayurvedic ingredients are a key component of Ayurveda, the traditional practice of medicine of India. Practitioners will generally use ayurvedic herbs to cleanse the body, boost defense against disease, and keep the mind, body, and spirit in balance. So much of western medicine is focused on the treatment of disease. While western medicine struggles to catch up to the ancient wisdom of preventive care, Ayurvedic medicine (powdered form) has for thousands of years offered practitioners the means to maintain health and stave off disease. To fulfill demands and satisfy each customer, many medium and small-scale organizations have taken the aid of Electrical powdered pounding machines to meet customer demands.
