ID AYU0236)for intake capacity in UG BAMS course with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) and 26 seats (Instead of 30 seats) in 5 PG course namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga- 03 seats (instead of 06 seats), (iv) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats), (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24 and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of appeal dated 08.09.2023-regarding.

## Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform youthat in pursuance of the provisionof National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act,1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

- 1. This is with reference to your first appeal filed by Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet- 600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236)vide ref no. SJSACH/GOG/D-533/2023 dated 08.09.2023 to the Commission against the conditional permission with seat reduction issued to Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet- 600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236)for intake capacity of 54 seats (Instead of 60 seats) UG (BAMS) and 26 seats (Instead of 30 seats) in 5 PG course namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga- 03 seats (instead of 06 seats), (iv) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats), (v) Shalya Tantra- 06 seats due to non fulfillment of the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016" and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in the permission letter dated 30.08.2023.
- 2. Thereafter the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and the Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee to provide an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the letter was sent to Principal of Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet- 600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236) vide Commission's letter Ref. No. NCISM/Comm./OPT Appeal/(2023-24)-(Tamil Nadu) dated 26.09.2023 to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on 27.09.2023 in respect of appeal to consider 60 seats in UG (BAMS) and 30 seats in 5 PG course namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga- 06 seats, (iv) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana- 06 seats, & (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24, filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the seat reduction permission letter dated-30:08.2023passed by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal were held virtually on 27.09.2023 at 3.00 PM and on behalf of the college, Dr. Chitharanjan Das, Principal of Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu attended the hearing.
- 3. The hearing committee sought clarification from the Dr. Chitharanjan Das, Principal of Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu regarding the the conditional permission with seat reduction issued by Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM, vide letter of even number dated 30.08.2023 which is as under:-

Shortcoming of 01 lower faculty in Kayachikitsa persists.

S, joined on 19.05.2023) after the filling of the visitation proforma and which was informed to the President MARBISM on 23.05.2023 through mail (Copy Enclosed Annexure-IV).  Availability of total teaching staff:  Availability of total teaching staff seats in UG is including Dr. Vijayarajaaand Dr. Shobita S, the number of available teaching staff for UG will be28.Hencethe% will be 93:33%.—	Regarding shortcoming of 01 Lower faculty in Shalakya Tantra College submitted that they have recruited Assistant Professor without Teacher's code (Dr. Shobita. S (AYSK01156), joined on 19.05.2023) after the filling of the visital proforma and which was informed to President MARBISM on 23.05.2023 through mail college stated that portal was closed in the month of May so they could not apply for teacher code college applied for teacher code on 29.07.2023 now teacher is linked with the current college and her experienced is considered from 19.05.2023 teachers cannot be considered.  Regarding shortcoming of 01 higher faculty, college submitted that One Professor of Shalakya Tantra, the offer of appointment is issued and Dr. Pundareekaksha Rao Punna has given his consent that after the inspection and his notice period he will be joining to our college.  Submission of college cannot be considered shortcoming of 01 higher faculty persists.

- 4. The submissions made by the Principal of Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu and observations of the hearing committee was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and it has been decided by the Chairman NCISM to consider the appeal of Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu dated 08.09.2023 for intal capacity in UG BAMS course with 60 seats and Prasuti & Striroga-03 seats (instead of 06 seats).
- 5. Further, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide letter no. NCISM/Comm./OPT Appeal/(2023-24)-(Tamil Nadu) dated 03.10.2023 to grant Conditional Permission to Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu for intake capacity in UG BAMS course with 60 seats and 26 seats (instead of 30 seats) in 5 PG course namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga- 03 seats (instead of 06 seats), (iv) Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats), (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2023-24.
- 6. Therefore, it has been decided by the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM to issue conditional permission to Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236) for intake capacity in UG BAMS course with 60 seats and 26 seats (instead of 30 seats) in 5 PG course namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga--03-seats-(instead-of-06 seats),-(iv). Rasa Shastra and Bhaisajya Kalpana- 05 seats (instead of 06 seats), (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seatsin compliance of the direction received in the letter dated 03.10.2023 by the Chairman, NCISM subject to following condition:-
  - I. The college shall submit an undertaking in the form of affidavit duly notarized within one month explaining the details of providing EPF and ESI facilities to the teaching, non-teaching staff of the Colleges/Hospitals and regularly paying the same as per the provisions of Employees' Provident Funds and Miscellaneous Provisions Act, 1952 & ESI Act, 1948 and relevant Rules and Regulations.
  - II. It is further informed that minimum 100% of undergraduate and postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 60 seats in UG BAMS course and 26 seats (instead of 30 seats) in 05 PG Course shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2023-24. The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the

- college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.
- It is also informed that determination of fee and all other charges in respect of 50% of seats in private Medical III. Institutions and deemed to be University should be as per the guidelines issued by NCISM vide ref no.BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16.09.2022. Fees of the remaining 50% of seats are to be fixed as per the quidelines of Fee Fixation/Regulatary Committee (FRC) of respective State/UT/Deemed to be University.
- 7. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations thereunder.
- Further, as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for 8. Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.
- Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
- 10. The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December, 2023and send a compliance report to get permission for the session 2024-25:
  - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016;
- All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Minimum Standards of Education in Indian Medicine) ii.) Amendment Regulations, 2016 (for Ayurveda);
- iii.) All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto, &
- iv.) All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Post-graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
- 11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2024-25.
- 12. Further, letter issued vide letter of even no. dated 30.08.2023 stands withdrawn.
- 13. Please acknowledge the receipt of this letter.
