Subject:- Grant of Conditional permission to Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236) with intake capacity of 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 30 seats in 05 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga-06 seats, (iv) Rasa shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana- 06 seats, (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder in respect of appeal dated 28.09.2024-regarding.

Sir/Madam,

With reference to the subject mentioned above, I am directed to inform you that in pursuance of the provision of National commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020, the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) has been repealed with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021. With effect from the said date, the Central Council of Indian Medicine constituted under sub-division (1) of section 3 of the Indian Medicine Central Council Act, 1970 (48 of 1970) shall stand dissolved. Now, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3) of the section 1 of the said Act, the Central Government hereby notifies that all the provisions of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine Act, 2020 has been come into force with effect from the 11th day of June, 2021.

1. This is with reference to your first appeal filed by the **Principal of Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236) dated 28.09.2024** to the commission in respect to Conditional Permission with seat reduction in 01 PG issued to **Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236) for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 27 seats (instead of 30 seats) in 05 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga-06 seats, (iv) Rasa shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-03 seats (instead of 06 seats), (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats** due to not fulfilling the basic eligibility criteria in terms of Regulation 3 of the "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for under-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", "Indian Medicine Central Council (Requirements of Minimum Standard for post-graduate Ayurveda Colleges and attached Hospitals) Regulations, 2016", and provisions under the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder and other shortcoming as mentioned in Conditional Permission with seat reduction in 01 PG letter dated 17.07.2024.
2. Thereafter, the said appeal was placed before the Chairman, National Commission for Indian System of Medicine and the Chairman NCISM constituted a Hearing Committee to provide an opportunity of hearing to the college. Accordingly, the hearing letter was issued to the **Principal, Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarathpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236) vide Commission's letter Ref. No. NCISM/Comm./Opt. Appeal/(2024-25)-(Tamil Nadu) dated 04.10.2024** to appear before the designated hearing committee as constituted by the Chairman, NCISM on **05.10.2024** in respect of appeal filed under section 10(1)(g) and section 24(3) of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine ACT, 2020 and to produce all relevant valid documents/records/ proof to substantiate the claims and make written submission and submit an authenticated copy of evidence/verifications to commission with shortcoming wise clarifications mentioned in the Conditional Permission with seat reduction in 01 PG letter dated 17.07.2024 issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM. The proceedings of appeal were held virtually on **05.10.2024** and on behalf of the college, **Dr. Chitranjan Das, Principal of the college** attended the hearing.
3. The hearing committee sought clarification from the **Dr. Chitranjan Das, Principal of the college** regarding shortcomings mentioned in the Conditional Permission with seat reduction in 01 PG letter dated 17.07.2024 issued by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM and observation made by the hearing committee which is as under:-

But He was joined the institute since 13/5/2019. Also he was present while visitation also. The college has submitted the supporting document was verified. (Annexure II). While hearing, committee is also observed OTMS of Dr. Virupaksha Gupta KL (AYRB01149) linked with the college. Hence, there is no deficiency of faculty in department. College is fulfilling for the Six seats in PG Rasashastra department. **Submission can be considered.**

4. The submission made by the **Principal, Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarethpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu** and observations of the hearing committee was placed before the Chairman, NCISM and it has been decided by the Chairman NCISM to consider the appeal for Grant of conditional permission to **Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarethpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu** for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 30 seats in 05 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga-06 seats, (iv) Rasa shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-06 seats, (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 as per the concerned acts & regulations.
5. Further, the Chairman, NCISM directed the President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM vide letter no. **NCISM/Comm./OPT Appeal/(2024-25)-(Tamil Nadu) dated 10.10.2024** to grant conditional permission to **Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarethpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236)** for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 30 seats in 05 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga-06 seats, (iv) Rasa shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-06 seats (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 for the academic session 2024-25 as per the concerned acts & regulations.
6. Therefore, in view of shortcomings and deficiencies mentioned as above, **conditional permission is granted to Shri Jayendra Saraswati Ayurved College, 4/295, Bangalore High Road, Nazarethpet-600123, Chennai, Tamil Nadu (Inst. ID AYU0236)** for intake capacity with 60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 30 seats in 05 PG courses in the subjects namely (i) Kayachikitsa-06 seats, (ii) Panchkarma-06 seats, (iii) Prasuti & Striroga-06 seats, (iv) Rasa shastra and Bhaishajya Kalpana-06 seats (v) Shalya Tantra-06 seats for the academic session 2024-25, under section 28 of NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant regulations thereunder.
 - I. It is further informed that minimum **100% of undergraduate and postgraduate seats** of the permitted intake capacity of **60 seats in UG (BAMS) course and 30 seats in 05 PG Courses** shall be treated as all India quota. The counseling for seats under all India quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority as designated by Central Government for A.Y. 2024-25. **The permission of the college stands withdrawn if the college fails to comply with the aforesaid direction of the Central Government/NCISM for all India quota or the students admitted thereunder.**
7. Admissions made in violation of the above conditions will be treated as invalid and action will be initiated under NCISM Act & Regulations there under.

8. Further, **as per Sub-section (7) of Section 29 of NCISM Act, 2020**, The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine may conduct evaluation and assessment of any University or medical institution at any time, either directly or through any other expert, having integrity and experience in medical profession, without any prior notice and assess and evaluate the performance, standards and benchmarks of such University or medical institution and if the college is found to be not maintaining the Minimum Essential standards as specified in the concerned Acts & Regulations then **in accordance of Section 28 (1) (f) of NCISM Act, 2020 the issued permission of the college shall deemed to be withdrawn and denial of permission shall be issued by MARBISM for stoppage of admission for that particular academic year or the subsequent year.**
9. Discrepancies, if any, may be immediately brought to the notice of Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine, NCISM.
10. **The following requirements should be fulfilled by the college by 31st December 2024 and compliance report should be submitted to MARB-ISM, in order to be considered for the grant of permission for the academic session 2025-26 as per rules:**
- All the requirements under the provisions of the NCISM Act, 2020 and relevant Regulations made thereunder should be fulfilled in toto.
 - All the requirements of Minimum Standard of infrastructure and teaching & training facilities as specified in NCISM (Minimum essential standards, assessment and rating for undergraduate Ayurveda colleges and attached teaching hospitals) Regulations, 2024.
 - All the requirements of the National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022.
 - All the requirements of the Indian Medicine Central Council (Post Graduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations, 2016;
11. The fulfillment of the conditions given above may be made within the time period specified and compliance report should be submitted by the college to President, Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine will verify that the conditions have been fulfilled for considering the permission for the academic session 2025-26.
