MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This memorandum of understanding (hereinafter "this MoU") is made and entered into, as of this 19 Day of NOVEMBER Month of 2024

Between

Shri Vishwakarma Skill University (SVSU), with its main Campus at VPO-Dudhola Palwal and transit office at Plot No-147 Sector-44, Gurugram-122003 is a State Govt University established and incorporated under Act 25 of 2016, State of Haryana (hereinafter referred as University represented by **Prof. (Dr.) Jyoti Rana, Registrar, SVSU** which expression shall, unless repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include its successors and assignors); as First Party

And

Sri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi Viswa Mahavidyalaya, Enathur, Kanchipuram, Tamil Nadu, India hereinafter referred to as "**SCSVMV**" represented by **Prof. G. Srinivasu, Vice-Chancellor (I/c), SCSVMV** (which expression shall, where the context so admits include its successors and permitted assignees); as Second Party

Partner Profile

Sri Chandrasekharendra Saraswathi Viswa Mahavidyalaya, formed under the aegis of Sri Kanchi Kamakoti Peetam Charitable Trust in 1993, is Deemed to be a University, accredited by NAAC with "A" Grade. It's located in a sprawling complex of 50 acres at Enathur, at a distance of about 4 Kilometres from Kanchipuram. The University has a unique focus on integrating traditional knowledge with modern scientific practices with a global outlook.

Purpose of MoU

The purpose of the MoU is to mentor the educational institution for skill development and support to establish of programs for a framework of exchange and collaboration in the areas of Skill Development & Training.

Key Areas of Cooperation

- **Skill Development**

Both Universities shall explore opportunities of developing programmes and skill development initiatives in the multiple areas. Both Universities shall be open to provide Internships and Skill based training to students as per their requirement.

- **Holding of Conference/Seminar/Workshop/Training/Symposia etc**

Both Universities shall facilitate the holding of Conference/Seminar/Workshop/Training/Symposia/Summer School/ training /Faculty Development Programmes/lectures etc to improve the exchange of knowledge and experience in the area of skill development.

- **Faculty & Student Exchange Programmes**

Both Universities shall support Faculty & Student Exchange Programs between both Universities depending upon the requirements and the experience for the benefit of the students and the research scholars.

- **Exchange of Information Collection through Knowledge Resources / Publications**

Both Universities shall facilitate exchange of information collection through support in exchange of books, journals, and teaching materials including textbooks, audio-videos, publications, reports, and other teaching aids.

- **Cooperative research on the area of mutual interest**

Both Universities shall work on the dissemination of current research outcomes and achievements for cooperative research in the areas of the mutual interest of both parties.

Confidentiality

Both parties agree to maintain the confidentiality of all proprietary information shared during the course of this collaboration. This includes but is not limited to, business plans, financial information, and intellectual property.


Period of validity

This MoU shall be initially valid for 5 years from the date of signing the MoU and it may be renewed subsequently by mutual consent of both parties.

Dispute Resolution

1. Any differences or disputes arise between the parties shall in the first instant be resolved amicably & mutually by the parties.
2. Any dispute arising or breach of any clause under this MoU, which could not be





amicably settled, shall be referred to the sole arbitrator appointed with the mutual consent of both the Parties for arbitration and the decisions of Arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties.

3. If the Parties herein failed to appoint Sole Arbitrator with mutual consent, then there shall be three Arbitrators, each Party shall appoint one Arbitrator, and the two appointed Arbitrators shall appoint the third Arbitrator who shall act as the Presiding Arbitrator and decision of the Arbitration shall be binding on both the Parties. The Language of Arbitration shall be in English. Any payment to the Arbitrator shall be paid by both the parties equally. The place of the arbitration shall be at Palwal.
4. This MoU shall be governed by the Indian Laws and subject to the either jurisdiction of Courts of Palwal.

Amendments

Any amendments to this MoU must be made in writing and signed by both parties.


Governing Law
