MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THIS MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING IS EXECUTED ON THIS 6th DAY OF NOVEMBER 2024

BETWEEN

Sri Jayendra Saraswathi Ayurveda College & Hospital, Nazrathpettai, Chennai and the Indian Institute of Technology, Madras have agreed to the following protocols governing their collaboration on research related activities.

1. SCOPE

The terms and conditions governing this MOU are more specifically described in Annexure – 1 to this MOU.

The scope of collaboration on research activities in this Memorandum of Understanding includes the following categories.

Research collaboration in the areas of mutual interest.

Faculty from both institutions will collaborate in the supervision of joint research in disciplines of mutual interest. All such joint research activities will be governed by the terms laid out in Annexure 2.

 Sponsorship of joint seminars and workshops related to research areas of mutual interest

2. CONFIDENTIALITY

Any and all material shared during the course of the Projects are confidential, including but not limited to the recommendations, information being shared, results, technology, hardware or software design, data, know how, trade secret, architecture, material, documents etc. (the "Confidential Information") and they shall not be made public or shared with any other party, without the prior written consent of the other Parties to this agreement or the Party to whom such Confidential Information belongs. Parties shall also enter into an appropriate non- disclosure agreement before the commencement of every Project.

- 3.1.2 Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained in this Agreement, both parties to this MOU, do not provide any guarantee, warranty or indemnity in connection with the Results/Reports/Analysis/Designs or specifications provided under this Agreement which are based on the conditions prevailing at that relevant point of time and the inputs received by the Consultant or client. Further neither the Consultant nor the Institute shall be in any manner liable for the use of the Results, any performance, negligence or the failure to perform on the part of the Architect, Client, builder, engineer, subcontractors, employees or workmen, any third party or its group companies or any employee or workmen of these parties or any other third party involved in the design, construction or restoration project. This MoU or its renewal and the actions taken under it may be reviewed at any time. Modifications may be made by mutual agreement and any amendment or extension to the agreement may be formalized by exchanging letters between the two parties.

Annexure 1

- Scholars pursuing post-graduation at SJSACH may attend joint seminars, workshops related to areas of mutual interest. In addition, they may also follow their thesis work at IITM.
- The host institution of students in this exchange program shall not levy tuition fees.
 However, the home institution may continue to charge fees as applicable.
- Participants will be subjected to the rules and regulations of the host institution and specific rules and regulations, if any.

Selection and Nomination of students for research

The selection and nomination of students interested in research are open throughout the academic year. The student information should be accompanied by the following:

- Curriculum vitae
- Statement of recommendation from the head of the department and guide/faculty of SJSACH.
- A specific outline of the research study at the host institution and a statement of objectives of the students concerning his/her research.

When the home institution forwards a nomination, its presumed that the sending institution considers the research scholar suitable for the proposed joint research activity and consents to the send the research Scholar if selected by the host institution. The host institution will evaluate the nomination and determine their suitability for selection under the student exchange program.

Where the exchange scholar is pursuing a research or implementation project as part of B.S, M.S, MD (Ayu), MS (Ayu), the host institution will provide a suitable faculty member to jointly assist(along with the supervisor in the parent institution) the exchange scholar in formulating research project or jointly supervising the exchange scholar if a research project has already been identified.

The host institution will inform the home institution of any academic or other problems that may arise during the student's research activity in the host institution. The host institution will take appropriate action under its established policy and procedures in consultation with the home institution to deal with such problems.
